

Daisies for Vicky Crochetathon in aid of Victim Support



On the 21st October 2017, Lisa from the Wee House of Crochet and Lynda-Rose from Lyndas Craft Room are hosting a Crochetathon at Hobbycraft Warrington to raise money for Victim Support, in memory of Vicky Wynne-Jones.

Victim Support is a charity that supports people affected by crime and traumatic events in many different ways. Hopefully the Crochetathon will raise plenty of money for such a worthwhile cause!

At least one big daisy square blanket will be constructed, using squares that are crocheted on the day and squares that have been sent through the post from the lovely people who would like to take part but are sadly too far away. Ideally squares will need to be received by Friday 20th October to be used at the Crochetathon, any squares arriving after this date will still be used.

The blanket will be raffled off and all funds raised will be donated to Victim Support, there is also a Just Giving page located here - www.justgiving.com/fundraising/lisa-hesketh2

Materials

DK yarn in white, yellow and colour of your choice
4mm crochet hook
Tapestry needle
Scissors

Abbreviations (pattern uses UK terms)

ch - chain

tr - treble crochet

sl st - slip stitch

2dtr cl - 2 double treble cluster. Yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull through 2 loops, 2 loops left on hook, yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull through 2 loops, 3 loops left on hook, yarn over pull through all 3 loops

3dtr cl - 3 Double Treble Cluster. Yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull through 2 loops, 2 loops left on hook, yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull through 2 loops, 3 loops left on hook. Yarn over twice insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull through 2 loops, 4 loops left on hook, yarn over pull through all 4 loops.

htr - half treble

dc - double crochet

tr2tog - treble crochet 2 together. Yarn over, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, 2 loops left on hook, yarn over, insert hook into the next st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, 3 loops left on hook, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

Pattern notes

Any brand of DK yarn is fine to use for the daisy squares, the only thing we ask is for the daisy middle to be yellow and the petals to be white (shades do not matter) Any solid colour can be used for the the rest of the square.

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Using yellow yarn, make an adjustable loop or a foundation ring, by working a ch4 and a sl st into the first ch to join.

Round 1

Continue with yellow, ch3 (counts as 1tr), 11tr in ring. Join with a sl st into the top of ch3 from beginning of round (12tr)
Fasten off yellow

Round 2

Join white yarn into the top of any tr, ch4 (counts as 1dtr), work a 2dtr cl in the same st, ch2.

*3dtr cl in next st, ch2. Repeat from * 11 times. Join with a sl st into the top of the 2dtr cl from the beginning of round (12dtr cl, 12 ch2 spaces)

Fasten off white

Round 3

Join your chosen yarn into any ch2 space, ch2 (counts as 1htr), 2htr in the same space. 3htr in the next ch2 space, 3htr, ch3, 3htr in next ch2 space.

*3htr in the next 2 ch2 spaces, 3htr, ch3, 3htr in the next ch2 space. Repeat from * twice more. Join with a sl st into the top of ch2 from beginning of round. (48htr, 4 ch3 spaces)

Round 4

Continue with same colour, ch3 (counts as 1tr), work 1tr in each htr along each side and 5tr in each ch3 corner space. Join with a sl st into the top of the ch3 from beginning of round. (68tr)

Fasten off yarn and weave in any loose ends.
